

Campground Rules & Regulations

Campground Season

- Camping season starts from April 1st and ends Nov. 1st each year (when temperature permits).
- Start-day may be delayed if campground temperature hasn't stay above 32° F for more than 5 days before April 1st.
- End-day may be advanced if weather forecast predicts campground temperature stays below 32 °F for more than 8 hours before Nov. 1st
- Water and electricity will be disconnected outside camping season.
- Advanced notice and manager approval are required to enter campground outside camping season. *No overnight-staying outside camping season.



RV Trailer / Motor Home

- Camper is responsible for keeping their RV and lot area clean and functional at all time. Fees will be charged to campers if maintenance or cleaning service is requested after clean-up notice.
- Each camper is responsible for behavior of their families and guests.
- Anytime, a family member come to use your RV, the campground owners/managers must be informed. No one age of 18 years old or younger shall occupy your RV at anytime without adult supervision.
- Sleeping is only permitted inside RV. No sleeping in cars, boats, or any other vehicle or shelter of any kind within the campground.
- When campers leave, make sure all lights and gas are off and water is turned off at spigot. Make sure to lock your refrigerator (preventing wild animals from getting your food.)
- All structure building (deck, shelter, shed, and etc.) are not allowed without owners'/managers' permission. Camper is responsible for utility lines cut or broken while building structure.
- No renting or sublease your RV unit or leased area. Inform the owners/managers if you are selling your RV and lot annual permit. Camper is responsible for cleaning the lot before transiting to a new camper.
- Winterize your utility lines at the end of the camping season. (drain all water lines, disconnected from electricity.)
- No tents of any size of kind will be permitted for any reason.



*Musics, Noise, and Quiet Time

- No music or continuous noise greater than 80 db (like noise of a lawn mower) should be heard at adjoining campsites or common area at anytime. Exception of unavoidable noise, e.g.. site construction, should be approved by owners/managers in advance
- No music, singing, conversation, or any kind of sound greater than 40 db (like refrigerator hum) should be heard at adjoining campsites or common area during quiet time from 11pm to 7am
