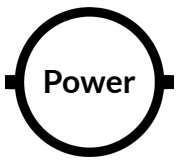


# Campground Rules & Regulations



## Trash

- Trash is to be placed INSIDE the dumpster and contained in trash bags. Do not dump loose trash in the dumpster. Lock the bar after dumping your trash bag in the container.
- No furniture, demo building materials, large trash (>3fts) are allowed.
- All fish to be cleaned at the fish station, and fish cleaning station needs to be cleaned with no left after complete. Cleaning left need to be put in the dumpster in a trash bag.



## Electricity

- 50 amps feasibility varies depending on lot locations. Please contact owners if you need to upgrade to 50 amps.

## Golf Cart & Bike



- No one without a driving license drives a golf cart.
- \*No golf cart or bikes on the hill that leads to SR 446, the walking trail to the school bus, or any area without pavement/gravel. Golf cart is not allowed outside of the campground (DNR rule with fine).
- Speed limit < 10 mph, drive with caution, and stop at all intersection.
- Must have properly installed lights to drive your cart at night. Anyone in violation of these rules will have their golf cart/bike privileges revoked



## Pets

- Pets must be on a leash at all times. Be respectful to your fellow campers and pick up after your dog and dispose of it in a bag.
- Dog barking needs to be controlled immediately.
- Camper is responsible and liable for their pets' behaviors.



## Tree Cutting & Leaves

- \*Live trees with potential hazards can be removed on request, and the cost is shared between MCC and the camper.
- \*Live trees without potential hazard should not be removed unless agreed by owners/managers., and camper is responsible of full cost.
- Do NOT gather brush or trees larger than 6" diameter for firewood.
- No tree cutting by the campers. Only certified personnel is allowed.
- \*MCC will collect leave piles from road sides in fall and spring. Campers can pile up leaves with blower by the road (do not use rack to pile up leaves).
- \*No leaf burning on the ground
