

Campground Rules & Regulations



Spring Clean-Up, 4/1 to 5/15 of Every Season

MCC is hands down the best campground by Lake Monroe because of the campers we have. Our campers treat this place like their second home and go all out to keep it looking top-notch. As the season kicks off, everyone pitches in to clean, prep, and add some extra flair to our little slice of paradise. Come join us in keeping this campground spick and span, and become part of our happy campground family.

- **1. Roof**

Make sure your roof is in good shape. Check for any damages, leaks, or rust, and get those fixed up pronto. Don't forget to clear off any leaves or tree branches that might be hanging around up there, and get rid of any pesky algae. And if you have to replace any parts, consider giving it a fresh coat of dark gray paint to keep it looking sharp. Your roof will thank you!

- **2. Structure**

Make sure to keep lots tidy and safe by clearing away any leaves and branches lying around. Check for any structures that might be damaged or leaning. Give everything a good power wash during the clean-up weeks (4/1-5/15) to get rid of any stains, dust, or algae buildup. And don't forget to take down those winter tarps when it's time to open up for the season.

- **3. RV / Trailer / Motorhome**

Keep your RV in top shape! Make sure the foundation is solid and secure, and all your electrical, water, and sewer lines are leak-free. And don't forget to give the exterior a good power wash during the clean-up weeks (4/1-5/15) to get rid of any grime or algae buildup.

- **4. Building Materials**

Need to clear out all the extra stuff from the project. That means getting rid of any leftover wood, boards, panels, stones, equipment, and furniture. And no sneaky moves like hiding stuff under the trailer or behind any structures, this will attract animals, trap moisture, develop molds, and eventually degrade your structure in long term.. Let's keep it clean and tidy, folks! Happy camping!

Any *campsite which has multiple violations* or any camper whose violation can cause *serious concerns* to the campground or other camper(s) can **lose its lease or subjected to immediate rejection (upon campground owner/manager's decision).**
