

Campground Rules & Regulations



Responsibility for Campground Maintenance

- Camper is responsible for keeping their RV and lot area clean and functional at all time. Fees will be charged to campers if maintenance or cleaning service is requested after clean-up notice.
- All structure building (deck, shelter, shed, and etc.) are not allowed without owners'/managers' permission. Camper is responsible for utility lines cut or broken while building structure.
- Winterize your utility lines at the end of the camping season. (drain all water lines, disconnected from electricity.)
- 50 amps feasibility varies depending on lot locations. Please contact owners if you need to upgrade to 50 amps.
- *Camper is responsible to move RV, structure, and any personal belongings for campground maintenance (ground repair, utility repair, or tree trimming/removal) when MCC deems necessary.



Trash

- Trash is to be placed INSIDE the dumpster and contained in trash bags. Do not dump loose trash in the dumpster. Lock the bar after dumping your trash bag in the container.
- No furniture, demo building materials, large trash (>3fts) are allowed.
- All fish to be cleaned at the fish station, and fish cleaning station needs to be cleaned with no left after complete. Cleaning left need to be put in the dumpster in a trash bag.



Golf Cart & Bike

- No one without a driving license drives a golf cart.
- No golf cart or bikes on the hill that leads to SR 446, the walking trail to the school bus, or any area without pavement/gravel. Golf cart is not allowed outside of the campground (DNR rule with fine).
- Speed limit < 10 mph, drive with caution, and stop at all intersection.
- Must have properly installed lights to drive your cart at night. Anyone in violation of these rules will have their golf cart/bike privileges revoked
