

# Campground Rules & Regulations



## Tree Cutting & Leaves

- Live trees with potential hazards can be removed on request, and the cost is shared between MCC and the camper.
- Live trees without potential hazard should not be removed unless agreed by owners/managers., and camper is responsible of full cost.
- Do NOT gather brush or trees larger than 6" diameter for firewood.
- No tree cutting by the campers. Only certified personnel is allowed.
- MCC will collect leave piles from road sides in fall and spring. Campers can pile up leaves with blower by the road (do not use rack to pile up leaves). No leaf burning on the ground




## Musics, Noise, and Quiet Time

- No music or continuous noise greater than 80 db (like noise of a lawn mower) should be heard at adjoining campsites or common area at anytime. Exception of unavoidable noise, e.g.. site construction, should be approved by owners/managers in advance
- No music, singing, conversation, or any kind of sound greater than 40 db (like refrigerator hum) should be heard at adjoining campsites or common area during quiet time from 11pm to 7am



## Power Wash

- Trailer must be washed at least once a year.
- Trailer and deck power wash is allowed from 4/1 to 5/15. Campers need to notice the owners about the power wash dates due to limited water supply.
- Weekday or by appointment only From 5/15 to 11/1,
- No car or boat wash is allowed in the campground.



## Parking

- Maximum of TWO (2) vehicles are allowed for each lot. Make sure all your vehicles are parked INSIDE your boundaries. Temporary parking for unloading has to be removed in 15 minutes. Extra parking at the Cutright can be available, and it is subjected to DNR regulations. (e.g. overnight parking is not allowed.)
- Respect Others. Don't take people's kindness for granted. Only park at your neighbor's lot when you notice them and receive permission ahead of time and every single time.
