

Campground Rules & Regulations



Pets

- Pets must be on a leash at all times. Be respectful to your fellow campers and pick up after your dog and dispose of it in a bag.
- Dog barking needs to be controlled immediately.
- Camper is responsible and liable for their pets' behaviors.



Fire

- Never leave a campfire unattended; An adult should supervise the campfire at all times.
- Fire only in the designated fire pit. Fire pit locations need to be approved by owners/managers.
- Burning plastic or any non-organic material is not allowed.



Safety

- MCC may ask an individual to leave the campground if the individual creates a disturbance that denies other guests their right to enjoyment of the campground necessary for the preservation of peace, health, or safety; or the individual has violated any federal, state, or local law while in the campground.

CAMPGROUND RULE VIOLATION will **first receive a warning**. The **campsite lessee will be fined from \$20-\$100 after the first warning** (amount is subject to campground owner/manager's judgement based on severity). Any campsite which has **multiple violations** or any camper whose violation can cause **serious concerns** to the campground or other camper(s) can **lose its lease or subjected to immediate rejection** (upon campground owner/manager's decision).

Campground owner retains the right at any time to change or impose additional rules. In no event does the campground owner assure any risk or responsibility for damage or loss to camping units, or other property, nor for personal injury to the campers, occupants or guests. The waiver by the campground owners of compliance by any camper or guest with any rule or regulation shall not operate or be construed as waiver of any rule or regulation (whether or not similar), or a continuing waiver or a waiver of any subsequent breach by camper or guest of any rule or regulation.
